FROM THE DIRECTORS PODIUM

First, a word of thanks to all who have assisted with this year's marching band activities. It takes many people working at many different tasks to keep everything going and this has been a great year for the Pope Marching Bands! Remember that we have the Marietta Veterans Day Parade upcoming. We also start preparation for our Hawaii Parade performance soon.

We are nearing auditions for second semester. They will take place in late October. Students were instructed during the first two weeks of school to download and begin practice on the materials for this audition. We use the Georgia Music Educators Association scales and etudes for our tryout (same as District Honor Band and All State Band).

Once auditions are complete, we will post band assignments for second semester. A good friend of ours tells their students the following about any audition:

There are FOUR possible outcomes...

- 1. You do well and make the group you hoped for
- 2. You do well and you don't make the group you hoped for
- 3. You don't do well and you make the group anyway
- 4. You don't do well and you don't make the group you wanted

In each scenario, there are many factors. You can't control how well others play. Only you are responsible for your own level of preparation. Remember... an audition is only a single snapshot of where you are at that moment in time. Much like a standardized test, it is used to measure achievement. It does not, however, measure every possible factor.

The best advice is to be well prepared and use the experience to learn how to deal with what can be a stressful situation (similar to college applications or a job interview).
