POPE BAND COMMUNICATION—HOW DO I KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON?

There are a few ways that the Pope Band will communicate information to you.

The Band Website has the band calendar! Go to www.PopeBand.com—click on the "Big Dates" tab and go to "Band Calendar"

This calendar can be automatically added to your device or Google calendar or Outlook calendar as a "feed." Click on the "+GoogleCalendar" button at the bottom of the calendar OR click on this <u>link</u> from your applications/device. *I highly recommend adding the band calendar to your personal calendar!*

Remind Texts—Receive texts from Mr. Rudolph with IMPORTANT last minute INFORMATION!

- Competition Marching Band: Parents text the message: @mrrudo to 81010
- Friday Night Band Only: Parents text the message: @fnb to 81010
- Band Class Only: Parents text the message: @coparents to 81010
- Students: Text the message: @popeband to 81010. Parents do not need to sign up for the student list!
- If you cannot text to 81010, then text the same text message to the number: (678) 335-5211
- ONLY sign up for ONE of the text groups, otherwise you will get duplicate messages!

Also, please take note of how to properly unsubscribe. If you only reply the word "unsubscribe" to the message it comes back to Mr. Rudolph as a response, but does not unsubscribe you from the list. **Unsubscribe** by texting the message: unsubscribe @mrrudo [competition band] or unsubscribe @fnb [Friday night band] or unsubscribe @coparents [concert band class] or unsubscribe @popeband [students] to 81010.

Pope Band Emails—We periodically email you and/or your student important information, as well as the monthly newsletter. If you are not receiving emails from us or you want to add or change your email address, log onto CHARMS. Do this by going to www.PopeBand.com then Click on the "Resources" tab, then go to CHARMS (in the dropdown menu), "school code"= popehsband, "student area password" = your password. Questions?
