Monday, May 28<sup>th</sup>. The race starts in the LA Fitness Center parking lot <u>2550 Sandy Plains Rd</u>, Marietta, at 7:30 a.m. Volunteers would need to check in at 6:30 a.m. and will be serving cups of water to runners.

For every group of 8 volunteers (14 years and older) that show up and work the race from start to finish, we earn \$150 plus 25 cents per athlete that crosses the finish line.
