What is Tri-M?

The Tri-M Music Honor Society is the international music honor society for high school students. It is designed to recognize students for their academic and musical achievements, reward them for their accomplishments and service activities, and to inspire other students to excel at music and leadership. Through more than 5,500 chartered chapters, Tri-M has helped thousands of young people provide years of service through music in schools throughout the world.

Students in Tri-M participate in a number of music related activities throughout Pope High School and the greater community. Within the high school they assist with concert preparation, administrative tasks and help fundraise for the Pope High School, Music Department and for donations to charity. Students in Tri-M are recognized throughout Pope High School as exemplary students and role models for younger musicians.

Pope High School Member Requirements

- Candidate must be a Junior or Senior enrolled at Pope High School.
- Candidate must obtain a 3.0 or above cumulative GPA.
- Candidate must be enrolled in their respective music program (band, chorus, orchestra) throughout their freshmen and sophomore years, and/or sophomore and junior years. Candidate must additionally be enrolled in their respective music program throughout their participation in Tri-M Music Honors Society.
- Candidate have a grade letter "A" in all music courses.
- Candidate must be willing and able to participate in monthly Tri-M meetings, community service projects, Recitals and Lectures, and other scheduled Tri-M activities. All events are mandatory.
 - All new inducted members must play on a recital annually. (solo, duet, or an approved small ensemble)
- Candidates must demonstrate respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, caring, and citizenship.
- Candidates must demonstrate musical leadership and leadership in character in their school and community.

Service Hours

- Students must obtain a minimum 6-hours of service hours throughout the 2020-2021 school year.
 - *This is reduced from the required 10-hours to reflect our current virtual learning scenario.
- Hours must be obtained through Tri-M sponsored events/service projects.
- Hours cannot be in congruent with other organizations.
- School concerts and gigs for ensembles do not count as service hours if the student is already participating for their ensemble class.

Dues

All students in Tri-M are required to pay early dues to offset the costs of running Tri-M. For the 2020-2021 school year, dues will be \$25.00 for all members. All students, including new members, will be required to pay dues by January 1, 2021. Students that do not pay the dues by this date are subject to removal from Tri-M. Dues are payable on "My Payments Plus".
